

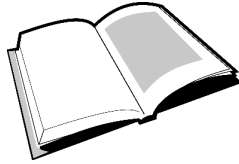

## Google Classroom

Students will use Google Classroom for announcements, updates, and assignments (as long as it does not infringe on copyright laws). Students should receive an email invitation to join Google Classroom within the first week of school. Students will be responsible for accepting the invitation. If a student does not have access to technology outside of school, they are responsible for letting Mrs. Cobb know. Mrs. Cobb will make arrangements with the student to complete the assignment(s).

# Policies

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## Absent work



Students will have the same number of days they were absent to turn in absent work. Students should check the absent folder when they are back in school to find any handouts they need. Students should also check Google Classroom.

## Technology



Cell phones are prohibited in the classroom. Phones need to be turned off and kept in your locker. If a student is using a cell phone in class, it will be taken to the office where parents will need to pick it up.

Students will be responsible for handling technology with respect. If a student does not respect technology, there will be a loss of technology privileges.

## Academic dishonesty



All work that is submitted must be your own work. You may not do any of the following:

- 1) Turn in or copy someone else's work.
- 2) Copy someone's work and change a few of the words.
- 3) Copying words from a source without citing it and giving credit to the source.
- 4) Attempt to use any notes on a closed-not assignment.
- 5) Look at someone else's work during an quiz, test, or otherwise individual assessment.

If you are doing any of the above or anything else that constitutes cheating, you will receive a zero on that assignment, and you will be referred for discipline.

## Other policies
